

COVID Protection Framework (traffic light system)

Golf New Zealand have reviewed COVID Protection Framework (CPF) and released their guidelines. Although golf can be played at RED, ORANGE and GREEN by vaccinated and unvaccinated players there are capacity limits and restrictions.

The Board of Northland Golf Club have reviewed the guidelines and from 3rd December have adopted the following policies at RED:

- All members/visitors to the course must use the COVID tracking system
- All members/visitors and staff in the retail shop must wear a face covering
- Alcohol sales in the retail shop will be limited to those with a My Vaccine Pass
- My Vaccine Pass is not required to use the Range
- My Vaccine Pass is not required for casual golf (but each four group must stay 2m apart)
- My Vaccine Pass **is required** to enter all events this includes all haggles, Christmas Cheer, and Twilight

The mandated CPF hospitality rules require a limit of 100 people in the Clubrooms and alcohol sales limited to those with a My Vaccine Pass.

Consumption of alcohol on the outside tables is limited to those with a My Vaccine Pass

Also, note the Hole in One café will also be following the mandated hospitality rules and sale of food and beverages in the café is limited to those with a My Vaccine Pass
