## **NORTHLAND GOLF CLUB Inc KING OF THE MOUNTAIN RULES AND CONDITIONS 2026**

- The event is net stroke-play over the year using a player's current handicap. There is only one division.
- Rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club and the local rules of the Northland Golf Club will apply to this event.
- The Alternate Stroke and Distance Rule does not apply in this competition.
- Play will be on Sundays unless otherwise authorised. Play can start at any time between daylight and 1 pm from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee using the blue markers.
- Temporary and standing local rules can be found on the inside and back of cards, the noticeboard, and the outside whiteboard.
- The only cards to be used are the Northland Golf Club printed score cards issued by the Club Shop. Digital cards are not to be used. All cards must be fully completed including signatures and either scanned in or entered at the Shop and handed over to the Shop attendant for collection.
- This is a net score competition and all players must hole out –gimmes are not acceptable.
- Net scores will attract a King of the Mountain Point total. The lowest net score(s) will be awarded the highest King of the Mountain scores. See the table below for the levels of points won. Players who tie with others will all get the same King of the Mountain score.
- The players with the 19 highest point scores will be invited to compete in the final. The rules of the final will be made available just prior to the date of the final. The top 19 scores will play off the 1st tee dropping off the worst score on each hole until the last two players reach the 18th hole where the winner will be decided!
- The Match Committee maintains the right to add rules and conditions or alter the current rules and conditions.
