



LB COLLISION TWILIGHT GOLF

AMBROSE RULES and CONDITIONS

9-HOLE 4-PERSON

The Northland Golf Club thanks LB Collision, Judge House of Ale and OMAK Meats for their continued and valued sponsorship.

1. The format is mixed 9-hole stroke play on handicap Ambrose golf.
2. The Royal and Ancient rules of golf apply. The local rules are on the back of the scorecard, inside in the right hand column, and on the Shop outside whiteboard.
3. An adjusted handicap will apply by adding together all player's 9-hole handicaps and dividing by twice the number of players. This might result in a fraction and does not have to be rounded up or down. That is the team handicap.
4. The markers to be used are white (men) and red (women).
5. Start as soon as possible after registering in Twilight Golf.
6. Teams should to have four players.
7. One team will play off the tee at a time.
8. Keep up the momentum – use ready golf.
9. Each player has two compulsory drives and these are to be marked on the score card.
10. The point where the chosen ball comes to rest (in the general area) is the reference point from which one club length can be used to play the next shots. This is to be within the same golf area but no closer to the hole. On the green it is one putter head from the spot of the chosen ball.
11. A team has holed out as soon as a ball from the team comes to rest in the hole.
12. No gimmes.
13. Fill in your card fully and have it signed by the Captain and marker before handing it in.
