TOP DOG COMPETITION - CALCUTTA

The qualifying round on 31 Aug struck very bad weather causing the event to be postponed until Sun 7 Sep. All players are requested to tee off so as to be able to congregate in the bar at 3.30 pm for the Calcutta.

Players need to arrange your own tee bookings for 7 Sep. Note that only 16 pairs will make the cut. Good luck to you all.

RULES OF GOLF NOT UNDERSTOOD

You cannot play a provisional ball for a ball in or virtually certain to be in a penalty area.

On our 13th fairway many golfers have played their tee or fairway shot into the penalty area on the right and then proceeded to play a provisional shot. This can incur the general penalty for playing from a wrong place; then the player must proceed to obey Rule: 8.6 (Relief options from red penalty area).

The options for relief having played into a red penalty area are:

- Stroke and distance
- Back on the line of relief
- Lateral relief

Note that the options **do not**

include playing a provisional ball.

Defined Areas of the Course

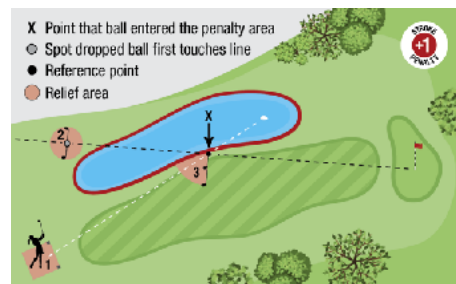
Temporary Local Rule: 15 cm mark, clean and place in the General Area.

This temporary local rule applies in the general area only and not the other four areas. Unfortunately some players are using it across the entire course area which means they are playing from a wrong place which attracts a general penalty.

Those areas NOT included in our temporary local rule are:

- The teeing area the player must use in starting the hole they are playing (Rule 6.2),
- All penalty areas (Rule 17),
- All bunkers (Rule 12), and
- The putting green of the hole the player is playing (Rule 13).

This should help players understand fully our local rule.
