RULES



This discussion came up during a recent Club championship.

You may only remove sand and loose soil on the putting green and not in the general area of the course. This means that if you're off the green wanting to putt and there is sand on your line both on the green and on the fringe (part of the general area) from a previously played bunker shot, you may wipe or brush the sand or loose soil away on the green but may not touch any that is lying on the fringe (unless that sand arrived there after your ball came to rest -

e.g., from another player's bunker shot after your ball had landed).
