NOTICE - CONSTRUCTION WORKS

For those who missed the notification last week: Papiwai Road will undergo pavement rehabilitation (Contractors Ventia) starting mid-September (about now) until February 2027. The area affected is from 76 Papiwai Road to the roundabout connecting Papiwai and Kamo Roads. Be prepared to alter routes and times to get to and from your golf games. 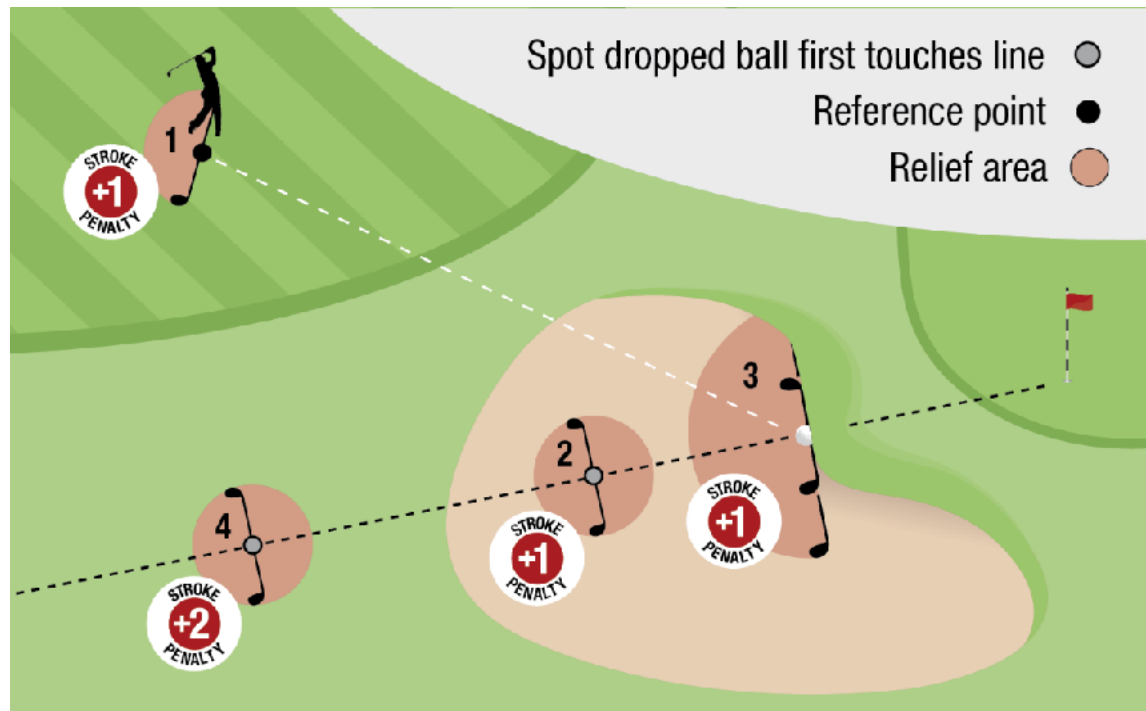

KNOW YOUR RULES OF GOLF

Rule 19.3. Relief Options for Unplayable Ball in Bunker

19.3a: Normal Relief Options (One Penalty Stroke)



A player decides that their ball in a bunker is unplayable. The player has four options:

- For one penalty stroke, the player may take stroke-and-distance relief.
- For one penalty stroke, the player may take back-on-the-line relief dropping in the bunker.
- For one penalty stroke, the player may take lateral relief by dropping in the bunker.
- For a total of two penalty strokes, the player may take back-on-the-line relief outside the bunker.

VOLUNTEERS TO BE MARSHALS

The Club is still looking for Marshals who can be available for two weekend-day periods a month on a roster system. Each duty might be for a continuous two or three hours during peak activity times.

The Marshal's role is to keep golfers moving, keep them safe, protect the course and ensure everyone has an enjoyable experience." A good Golf Course Marshal should be calm, patient, and possess excellent communication skills. They should be able to deal with any issues or disputes that arise on the golf course professionally and efficiently.

An understanding and love for the game of golf are also essential qualities.

All volunteers will be briefed and undergo an induction duty day.

**Top Dog - extension of Round 2*

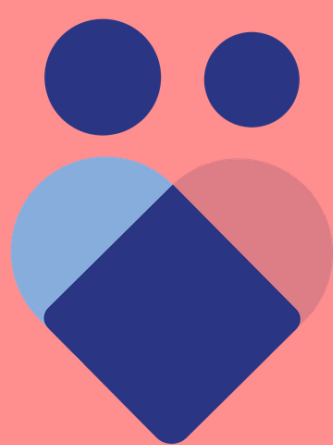
