KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

Ball Hits Another Ball or Marker - Rule 11

If you putt on the green and your ball hits a ball at rest on the green, you will incur 2 penalty strokes. You have to play your ball as it lies and the ball which was moved must be put back. (If this happens after you have played from off the green, you will not incur a penalty). In Match Play, continue play without penalty and put the moved ball back.

If a ball is deflected by a ball-marker, this is classed as a chance occurrence - play the ball as it lies without penalty.


