RULES OF GOLF NOT UNDERSTOOD

Alternate Stroke and Distance Rule

Reference: R&A Rules of Golf- Committee Procedures Section 8, Rule E-5.

The alternate stroke and distance rule is available as an ongoing local rule with normal weekly haggles and competitions for men, women and junior golfers. It is normally invoked in order to save time rather than going back to the point where the previous shot was played. However, the use of this rule has to be made clear to players by the competition convenor. Generally the rule is available for any competition except for interclub, Northland level, and representative golf. If anyone is unsure then please ask the competition convenor. The normal stroke and distance rule remains available no matter if stated or not by the event convenor (Rule 18).

If a player is unsure what rule applies play a provisional from the place where the previous stroke was made and then continue.

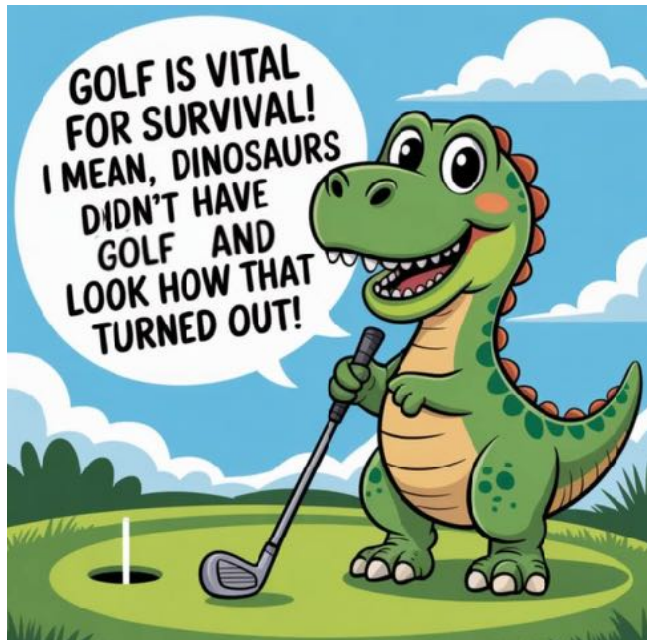
