Unfortunately the bad weather necessitated the need to cancel this event. To this end the Club is now officially opened for 2026 as at Sun 18 Jan. Good golfing for 2026.

KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

Over the next ten weeks a short explanation of the rules commonly queried by Northland Golf Club players will be posted. Anyone who would like to have a specific rule included should contact the Golf Shop who will pass it on to the Tee Times editorial team.

Rule 8.6: Relief Options Red Penalty Areas. When a player is in a red stake penalty area the following options are available to you:

1. Play the ball as it lies (no penalty).
2. Relief - replay from the original shot location (stroke and distance for 1 penalty).
3. Relief - back-on-line (1 penalty). Choose a spot as far back-on-the-line from the hole through the point the ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area. Drop the ball on the spot. The ball must come to rest within one club length in any direction from where the ball first strikes the ground when dropped..
4. Relief - lateral (1 penalty). Drop a ball within 2 club lengths from point of entry, no nearer the hole.

Note: there is NO mention of playing a provisional ball.
