
Please don't be offended if you are asked to show your membership card; checking the cards is helping protect the integrity of our golf course and Club.

KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES



Today's Topic: Ball at Rest Moved by an Outside Influence - Rules 9 and 14

The course has frequent visits from a cat that sometimes waits on the 9th green and "sneaks up" on the ball after it has come to rest.

If your ball at rest is moved by an outside influence (spectator,

animal, another player, other ball etc.) you must put your ball back without penalty. If your ball has been picked up and taken away, you are permitted to place another ball on the spot where the ball was, without penalty. If you do not know the original position, it must be estimated as accurately as possible..

Match Play: If your ball is moved by the opponent during a search, there is no penalty. If a search is not involved, the opponent usually incurs 1 penalty stroke. The ball has to be put back.

These rules have many parts to them; please read Rules 9 and 14 for more detailed information.
