### FIVE-PERSON GROUPS

When the course is busy or has major events under way, players must avoid forming groups of five inevitably delaying following groups. Rather it is expected that a group of five should split into a two and a three or make up groups of four. Any 5-player groups seen on the course will be told to adopt these guidelines.

### PLAYING THE 7TH HOLE

When players are teeing off the 7th, some are deliberately playing for the 8th fairway. This is taking a short cut and lacks integrity in playing the 7th. In addition it places anyone coming up the 8th in danger of being struck by a ball. The 8th is hard enough without errant golfers playing the 7th by way of the 8th fairway. Accept the challenge and play on your own fairway.

#### Know your Golf Rules - **Today's Topic: Adjusting Clubs on Course – Rule 4.1a.**

You are not allowed to use the adjustability feature on your driver or any other club during the round. If you do so, you must put it back to its original setting before you make a stroke. If you don't, and you play a shot, you will have broken Rule 4.1a and will be disqualified.
