KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

Every week there are queries on a ruling or a request for advice on the rules. It is pleasing that players are keen to get the rules right and to use them properly.



Today's Topic: Advice and Line of Play - Rule 10.2

You are allowed to discuss distances, the position of bunkers or penalty areas, the pin position, the rules and other facts. If you cannot see the green from the tee, you are allowed to ask someone to indicate its position. However, you are not allowed to ask for or give advice before the shot ("Which club did you take", "Take a 7 iron.") otherwise 2 penalty strokes will be incurred.

A player who is given unsolicited advice does not receive any penalty strokes. See Rule 10.2 for more information on "Advice".
