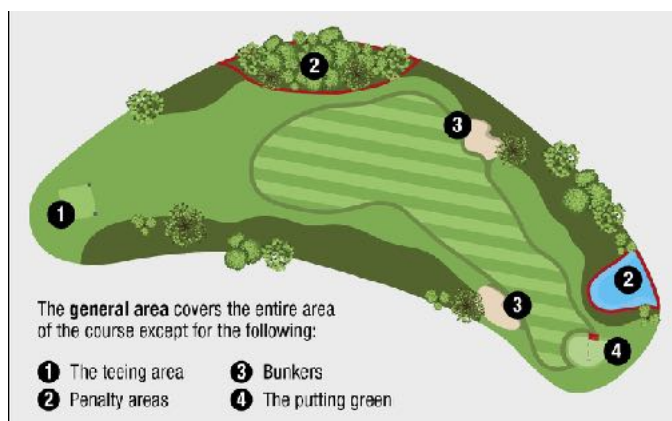

R&A RULES DEFINITIONS

What is "Through the Green" and "The General Area"? The term "Through the Green" was replaced a few years back by "The General Area". This is the area of the course that covers all of the course except for the other four defined areas: (1) the teeing area the player must play from in starting the hole they are playing, (2) all penalty areas, (3) all bunkers, and (4) the putting green of the hole the player is playing.

VOLUNTEERS TO BE MARSHALS

They should be able to deal with any issues or disputes that arise on the golf course professionally and efficiently. An understanding and love for the game of golf are also essential qualities. Anyone who considers they have the right skills and wants to volunteer should notify the Club Shop or ring them on (09) 435 1777. All volunteers will be briefed and undergo an induction duty day.
