COURSE PROJECTS

Many of you will notice some construction work around the course being done over the last year or so. Here is an update to what is being done and what we are trying to achieve.

15th Blue tee - This tee had a big slip behind it from cyclone Gabriel which has been fixed and the tee has been rebuilt and should be back in play soon

New 19th (spare) hole- We are constructing a new hole between the 11th and 12th holes. The club has plans to do lots of construction on the course, this may include rebuilding greens and resurfacing fairways which will require complete holes to be temporarily closed so the 19th hole will be brought into play when needed but will not be a permanent hole.

Couch grass trial-Some of you may have noticed a GUR area between the 4th and 5th fairway that we have been growing some grass. The purpose of this is to establish a grass we want to use on our fairways, we have narrowed it down to the two types growing in this area (both couch grass or as the Americans call it Bermuda grass)

Paths-There is a plan in place to upgrade the

paths- There is a plan in place to upgrade the paths on the golf course to concrete so there is not as much damage and maintenance after all the storms we get.
