KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

Today's Topic: Player Conduct - Rule 1.2.
 All players are expected to play in the spirit of the game by acting with integrity, showing consideration to others, and taking good care of the course. There is no penalty under the Rules for failing to act in this way however read Rule 1.2 for more information on serious misconduct.

Here is a list of points that player conduct requires:

1. Don't talk while others are playing their stroke especially on conjoined tees.
2. Music - should not be played at a volume that would bother ANY other players.
3. Avoid moving or standing behind someone playing a shot on or off the green.
4. Be careful where you walk on the green - avoid your fellow golfers putting line.
5. Maintain a pace of play so that others behind are not continually waiting.
6. Call faster players through - or speed up the pace of your own group.
7. Don't hit into the group in front - this is an unsafe practice and rude.
8. Yell "Fore" (right or left) when your ball goes in the direction of other golfers.
9. Minimise damage to the course - fix your divots and pitch marks.
10. Marking your ball on the green - politely comply, it's not hard.
11. Don't delay at the end of a hole - record the last scores at the next tee box.
12. Advice on rules - don't be offended if you are advised on a rule.
13. Get off the phone - turn it off or put it on silent.
14. Respect - have respect for other players, the course, rules and the game.
