Season One starts on Wed 28 Jan and after ten rounds, finishes on 1 Apr. The first round will be a stroke play format using all 14 clubs. Tee-off is between 3.30 pm until 5.45 pm. KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

Rule 18: Out of Bounds. It is important for the Committee to mark the boundaries properly and to maintain the markings so that a player who hits a ball near a boundary can determine if their ball is in bounds or out of bounds. Boundary stakes should be white, but another colour may be used.

If a ball at rest is out of bounds the options are:

1. The player may replay from the original shot location (stroke and distance) for one penalty stroke.
2. The player may use the alternate stroke and distance rule when it applies, for two penalty strokes See Model Local Rules (MLR) E-5 on the score card.

A provisional ball may be played if the ball goes out of bounds or is suspected of doing so but not for option 2.

- A player may not play a ball that has come to rest in an out of bounds area.
- White stakes, although movable, are deemed to be immovable objects and must not be moved (MLR 8.A-6). A breach of these rule incurs the General Penalty (2 penalty strokes).

HEALTH AND SAFETY - THE USE OF CARTS

The electric carts hired out are primarily to carry a maximum of two persons around the course. Each cart has a sign-in sheet that states the safety rules for using the cart. In addition each cart has a decal on the front screen area that clearly defines the rules.

Passengers are not to stand on the rear of carts and drivers are not to carry more than one passenger (adults or children). Please ensure the safety of yourself, pedestrians and passengers alike when using a hire cart.
