## DAMAGE TO THE COURSE

**Divots.** The wide cross-section of players enjoying their golfing experience includes some who leave behind damage to fairways and greens. After the ANZAC Day tournament on Saturday some divots (see picture) were not repaired. The divots were close by and easily recovered. The fact that they weren't replaced indicates that the players are either novices or careless experienced players. Either way it is unacceptable for anyone to not repair the damage caused by a divot. If a player's ball comes to rest in a divot, the rules require them to play the lie which makes the next shot a very difficult one.



**Greens.** The construction and care of a green require high costs and endless hours of meticulous work to sustain daily use of it. Anyone on a green must take great care to not damage the surface. Damage might include:

- shoe scuff marks,
- not repairing pitch marks,
- incorrectly repairing pitch marks,
- club or hole-pin striking or dropping to the surface,
- use of wrong footwear creating pressure-point indentations, and
- playing a ball off the surface of the green.

## KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES



**Today's Topic.** Ball in or suspected to be in a red penalty area.

This rule has been discussed on many occasions. The R&A states quite clearly that playing a provisional is not an option. You can only play a provisional ball if you think your ball may be lost outside of a penalty area or out-of-bounds. Rule 18.3.
