JOB VACANCY

Following significant membership growth over the past five years, the Board recently completed an Organisational and Operational Review. The findings highlighted that our current operational structure needs updating and our staff are at capacity. To assist **Jo Bruncker** (Golf Operations Manager) and **Iain Power** (Greens Superintendent), we are introducing a General Manager role. To test and refine the scope before committing to a full-time position, we are initially recruiting for a **6-month Project Based Fixed-Term Contract at 20 hours per week**.

- Embedding our updated Health & Safety system
- Leading the upcoming greens shed project
- Managing corporate sponsorships and community trust grant applications
- Implementing administrative and financial improvements

Here are a few reminders, especially for the weekend and for new players.

- Get to the golf course early and prepare yourself.
- Play ready golf and keep up the pace.
- Replace or fill your divot, repair pitch marks.
- Music on the course: A good rule of thumb is that music shouldn't be played at a volume that would bother other players on the course, and you should always ask the rest of your group if they are OK with it.
- Mobile phone golf etiquette - having cell phones on the course is generally permitted, but please silence your phone. Mobile phones are often used with golf apps that help you navigate the course or keep score, so they are part of the game now.
- This is a reminder of the rules for the use of golf carts at Northland Golf Course.

They are:

- All passengers must be seated – maximum of 2 persons per cart
- Keep carts 5 metres away from all greens, bunkers and tee box areas
- Follow directional signs regarding carts on the course
- Be aware and considerate of golfers on foot
- Any damage must be reported immediately to Shop staff
- The hirer is liable for any damage to the cart or course
- Drivers must be 18 years and over, and hold a current driver's licence
- BYO alcohol is NOT permitted
