have been washed down making a huge difference. A huge thanks to the team at Washrite.

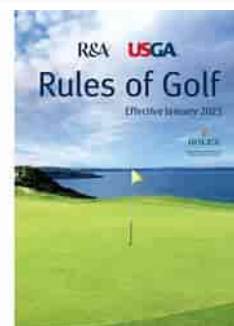


WAIPU MEN'S OPEN - LION TOUR EVENT
