## ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

**Important Update: Incorporated Societies Act 2022** New rules mean all societies-including ours-must reregister and update their constitution by 5 April 2026. Key changes include:

- New reporting requirements
- A formal dispute resolution process
- Clearer roles and powers for the committee
- An Interest Register must be kept

We're also making a few extra updates:

- More flexibility for scheduling our AGM after our financial year ends (30 August)
- Shorter notice period for General Meetings: now 10 working days
- Board members will serve 3-vear terms

To approve these changes, we'll need 75% **support** from those attending the AGM. More details will come with the AGM notice - keep an eye out, and thanks for bearing with the extra reading this year!

#### **RULES**

#### Rule 4.4 Allowing Faster Groups to Play Through

"If a group cannot keep its position on the course for whatever reason, and is delaying the group behind, then it should invite the group behind to play through so that a group can play at the pace it is capable of. Sometimes, if a number of groups on the course are playing slowly, playing through does not always achieve its objective, but it remains good etiquette." Groups larger than four are not allowed on the course during weekends.
