# RAKES AND BUNKERS

Has this ever been your situation? The ball is caught under a rake, close to the edge of the bunker, and on a downslope. Not a good scenario.

There have always been arguments for and against where the rakes should be placed: in the bunker, outside the bunker, in a pipe stand, etc.

After discussions with the Greens staff and the Match

Committee, it was agreed that the following would be applied: After playing out of a bunker and raking it smooth again, the rake is to be placed back in the bunker flat surface with minimal disruption to the sand. This will normally be the centre of the bunker

away from the bunker edge. Any ball caught up by the rake can then be played from a smooth even surface away from any interference from the bunker edge.
