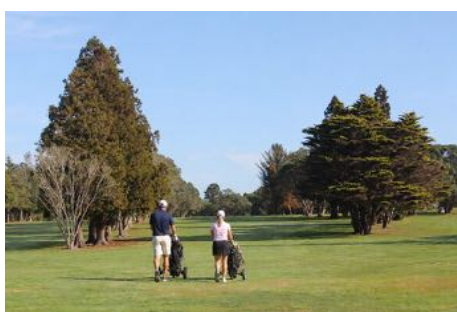
KENSINGTON DENTAL CARE MIXED PAIRS

DO YOU KNOW HOW TO FIX A PITCH MARK?

The depression of a pitch mark can tear the roots
beneath the surface, and if left unrepaired the grass in
that pitch mark often dies within days.

Both fairway divots and pitch marks on a green fall
under the same responsibility. If you made it or found
it, you should fix it. Here is an easy to understand
sequence to fix a pitch mark:

- **Mark Your Ball:** Before repairing a pitch mark, if your ball is on the green, place a ball marker behind it to avoid moving it accidentally while fixing the mark.
- **Use a Repair Tool:** Insert the prongs of the tool at the edges of the pitch mark, not the centre. Gently push the surrounding turf toward the centre of the mark. Avoid lifting the centre turf upward, as this can damage the roots.
- **Smooth the Surface:** After pushing the edges in, lightly tap the repaired area with your putter or foot to level it with the surrounding green. This ensures a smooth roll for future putts.
- **Check for Proper Repair:** The pitch mark should be nearly flush with the green. Properly repaired pitch marks typically heal within 24-48 hours, while unrepaired or improperly fixed marks can take weeks to recover and may leave brown spots or uneven surfaces.

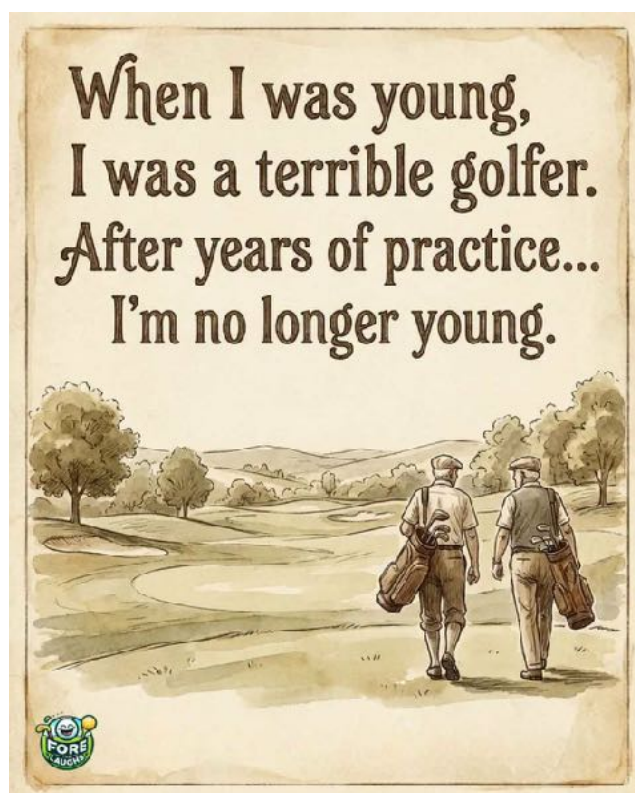
