KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES



Today's Topic: **Rule 6.4a(2): Playing out of turn in match play.**

Opponent May Cancel Player's Stroke Made Out of Turn. If the player plays when it was

the opponent's turn to play, there is no penalty but the opponent may cancel the stroke:

- This must be done promptly and before either player makes another stroke. When the opponent cancels the stroke, they cannot withdraw the cancellation.
- If the opponent cancels the stroke, the player must, when it is their turn to play, play a ball from where that stroke was made (see Rule 14.6).
- If the opponent does not cancel the stroke, the stroke counts and the ball is in play and must be played as it lies.

AMBROSE SERIES Competition Format

1. Winners of Club qualifier events will compete at the Regional Final after which the Northland winners will compete against the Harbour winners at Te Arai Links.
2. The Northland Golf Club Qualifier is an open event.
3. The winning team will be eligible to play in the North Golf Regional Final on Sat 2 May at Northern Wairoa Golf Course. The second place getter will be asked to be the Club reserve.
4. The Northland Region Champion Team faces off against the Harbour Region Champion Team at Te Arai Links in May (date TBC).
5. Teams of three players can be all men, all women, mixed gender, and include junior players.

Handicap Rules

1. Players must have an actual WHS handicap and have a membership in the district they are qualifying in.
2. Maximum individual handicap - capped at 36.
3. Team Handicap = (Sum of 3 players' handicaps) divided by 8.
4. Final score is the total strokes over 18 holes minus the team handicap.

Ambrose Format

1. Two teams will tee off together.
2. All players tee off.
3. Choose best shot.
4. Other players place their ball within one club length (no closer to the hole).
5. Repeat the process until the ball is holed.
6. On the green, mark the best ball and all putt from there.
7. Record one team score per hole.

Additional Rules

1. Minimum of 4 tee shots per player (record on scorecard).
2. No gimmes - all putts must be holed.
