NORTHLAND GOLF CLUB MEN'S OPEN

COMING UP IN THE CLUB

NORTHLAND GOLF CLUB MATCH PLAY QUALIFYING ROUND - SUN 14 JUN

The Club Match Play qualifying round will be gross stroke play over 18 holes starting off the 1st tee, blue markers, from 8.04 am. D Grade will play off the white markers. Players can still register until 5 pm Thu 11 Jun by signing on the lists on the Shop noticeboard. On Sun 14 Jun all registered players are requested to be at the Club Shop no later than 7.45 am. Groups of four will start off the 1st Tee at 8.04 am until approximately 9.42 am. The draw will be based on Seniors starting first, then Intermediate, Juniors and D Grade. It will be put on the Club's online "Events" site and also on facebook.

General play will be available to start off the 1st tee by 11.00 am. *General players will not be able to play through the competition field and the pace of play may not be fast.*

THE STEINLAGER SERIES FINAL - SUN 21 JUN

The final will be held at the Northland Golf Course where 60 players will all start off the 1st tee at 9 am until about 11 am. The course will be open for general play from 12 midday. Any players following the last group must accept that the pace of play could be slow and that playing through will not be possible. If there is a tie for the winners there may be delays on the 18th whilst a sudden death playoff is underway.

Ball spotters are needed for the 11th, 13th, and 16th holes so that delays in finding balls are minimised. If you can be available you would be needed from 11 am until approximately 2.30 pm. For more details contact the Shop on 09 435 1777.

KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

Today's Topic: Rain, rain, and more rain. Keeping your clubs and hands dry. See Rules 4.3 and 10.2 for more details. Here are some of the CAN DO things:

- You can wear gloves designed to be tacky when wet.
- You can towel off the grips of your clubs before swinging.
- You can wrap a towel around the handle for a better grip.
- You can change gloves as often as you want.
- You can hold an umbrella over your head while putting.
- You can use some type of drying powder on the handles.

Here are some of the CAN'T DO things:

- You can't have someone else shield you from the elements while swinging.
- You can't use any equipment that gives you an unfair advantage with hand or grip pressure.
- You can't pull your shirt sleeve down to hold onto the club while making a stroke

This last one deserves a little explanation as you are allowed to hold a towel on the grip or wear special rain gloves. Rule 10.1b/2 "If the player deliberately uses a gripping hand to hold an article of clothing worn on any part of the body (such as holding the sleeve of a shirt with a hand) while making a stroke, there is a breach of Rule 4.3 (Prohibited Use of Equipment) since that is not its intended use and doing so might assist the player in making that stroke."
