### LIONS CLUB CHARITY TOURNAMENT





### KNOW YOUR GOLF RULES

#### Today's Topic: **Out of Bounds and Provisional Ball – Rule 18.2a**

A ball at rest is out of bounds only when all of it is outside the boundary edge of the course. A ball is in bounds when any part of the ball:

- Lies on or touches the ground or anything else (such as any natural or artificial object) inside the boundary edge, or
- Is above the boundary edge or any other part of the course.



A player may stand out of bounds to play a ball on the course.

A player may play a provisional ball if they suspect that their ball is out of bounds. A provisional ball can be played from the original spot where the suspected out of bounds ball was played from.

This message is put in the Tee Times for the benefit of new golfers and some others who may have forgotten these rules.
