### RULES OF GOLF NOT UNDERSTOOD

Over the next ten weeks the Men's Club Captain will include an article on the rules of golf that might help Club members understand easier some confusing rules.

**First Rule: Sprinkler head lies between your ball and the hole.**

It's important to know that this is not an automatic relief scenario under the Rules of Golf. Yes, if your ball actually lies on the sprinkler head or it interferes with the area of your intended stance or swing, you would be entitled to free relief, but not just because it is on your line and you really want to putt it.

However, some courses (not Northland Golf Club) will have a Local Rule allowing relief but if no such Local Rule exists, there is no free relief, so always check the scorecard or noticeboard for the local rules.
