

NORTHLAND GOLF CLUB TOP DOG RULES - 2025

As at 14 Jul 25

- 1. **Participation:** Club Members only.
- 2. **Qualifying Round:** The qualifying round will be 18 holes combined net for men's pairs playing in a group of four. **Start Procedure:** Groups are to arrange their own time and must play off the 1st tee from the blue markers. The results of the round will be used to create a seeded draw. A maximum of 16 teams will qualify.
- 3. Handicap: the highest handicap is 24.
- 4. **Competition Rounds:** This will be Four-Ball Match Play on Handicap. You and your partner compete together as a side, with each of you playing your own ball, and your side's score for a hole is the lower net score of the two of you on that hole on Handicap.
- 5. **Rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club** and the Local Rules of the Northland Golf Club as displayed at the club will apply to this event.
- 6. **The Match Committee** shall rule on any matters brought to their attention within 15 minutes of the end of the round. The Committee's decisions shall be final.
- 7. **Start Times for Competition Rounds:** Bookings must be made as normal. Teams are to arrange their own start times. This competition is based on the "on or before" basis not "on XX date". All play is to start on the 1st tee using the blue markers.
- 8. Playoffs: If a match ends in a draw then a sudden death playoff is to be done 18th hole (2x), 1st hole, 17th hole.
- 9. **The winning pairs** of each match are to report results to the Shop directly after the match.
- 10. The Alternate Stroke and Distance rule does not apply in this competition.
- 11. Golf carts are allowed to be used.
- 12. Local Rules can be found on the back of the player's score card.
- 13. **Temporary Local Rules** can be found on the inner right-hand side of the scorecard and on the Shop external whiteboard.
- 14. Knowledge of these Rules is necessary in order to play a successful round.
- **Both team players** must agree to be available for all planned rounds.
- **Dispensation** will only be given for family bereavement or club representations.
